President	OPEN	Run Board meeting, Member Updates, represent BC at meetings, approve expenditures
Past-President	John Varol	Provide incoming President with background of past decisions, approve expenditures
Vice-President/Secretary	OPEN	Provide support to President, take and provide meeting minutes, approve expenditures
Treasurer	Cheri Clark	Maintain financial records, prepare gate/concession boxes

Executive Board also responsible for the recruitment of new Board members and will serve as the nominating committee for the Executive Board and/or Committee Chair appointments. They are voting members of the BC Board.

<u>Committee Chairs</u>	<u>Servant</u>	<u>Responsibilities</u>
Membership	Michael Hutchison	Annual/Seasonal membership drive, distribution of membership packages and gifts
Communications	OPEN	Website updates, member communications, and promotion of special events
Scheduling	Mindy Holden	Work with Team Moms to develop work schedules for events, solicit volunteers
Concessions	OPEN	Purchase food for concession stands, set up concessions prior to games
Special Events	Stacy Adams	Oversight for Annual Apparel Sale, Spirit Store, Golf Tournament

Committee Chairs are also voting members of the BC Board. They are encouraged to develop teams and sub-committees to complete the work under their area of responsibility.

<u>Special Event Coordinators</u>	<u>Responsibilities</u>
Golf Tournament	Run annual golf tournament fund raising event
Apparel Sale	Run annual Apparel Sale
Spirit Store	Purchase, stock and run Spirit Store
Tournaments	Run special tournaments such as Golden Corral MS BB, Varsity Christmas BB, etc...

Special event coordinators are not voting members of the BC Board. They may attend all BC Board meetings (although not required unless requested by the Board for status updates).
